

Slide bracket along straps to achieve desired position.
The straps have perforations running their length with one inch spacing.

The bracket has a series of 8 indexing holes per strap location allowing it to be indexed at 1/8" intervals, as the bracket slides along the straps note that with each 1/8" of travel one of the 8 indexing holes comes into alignment with one of the 1" spaced holes on the strap. Sheet metal screws are provided to fix the bracket in the desired location.

Nail or screw metal straps to framing.

Grooves indicate centerlines of bracket.

Wood or Metal Framing
