

## Installation

- 1) Remove the front speaker grille
- 2) Remove or breakthrough the 4 stickers covering over the 4 holes on the front of the soundbar with a pencil. Make sure that the pencil passes through the holes on the back of the soundbar (Fig. 1)



- 3) Hold the soundbar up to the wall at the desired mounting location
- 4) Place a level on top of the soundbar. Once level, pass a pencil through the 4 exposed holes and mark their location on the wall (Fig. 2)



- 5) Remove the soundbar and run the provided gasket tape around all four sides on the back of the soundbar, 1/4 inch from the edges
- Use a stud finder to determine if the marked locations are over a stud or open area (Fig. 3)




- 7) If the marked locations are NOT over a stud, use the provided toggle bolts and anchor them into the wall at the marked locations
- 8) Run the speaker wire through the provided cable management channel on the back of the soundbar and wire into the applicable speaker terminals.

\*\*\*\*You may need to strip the initial sheathing off of the speaker wire depending on which gauge wire you are using



- 9) Place the soundbar back onto the wall making sure to line the holes up with the marked locations while pushing the excess speaker wire back into the wall
- 10) Use the applicable hardware to mount the soundbar to the wall by passing through the 4 holes on the front of the bar into the wall anchors with bolts or study with screws
- 11) Replace the front grille
